The academy is a tuition-free, state-accredited online public school operated by Grapevine-Colleyville ISD, and is one of only three public virtual education solutions in the state offering elementary, middle and high school programs. iUniversity Prep is a customized learning opportunity for students who want a rigorous choice, and a college prep education from a distinguished school district.

### **Recognition**

In 2014 the Texas Education Agency rated iUniversity Prep one of the highest performing virtual schools in the state.

### **By the numbers**

iUniversity Prep employs 17 full-time state certified and highly qualified teachers.

Approximately, 350 students are currently enrolled in iUniversity Prep.

All students living in Texas who are in fourth through 12<sup>th</sup> grade are eligible for enrollment.
